


# WORKING WITH CHILDREN

## CHILD CENTRIC APPROACH

As stated by the Juvenile Justice Act 2015, it is always best to consider the best interest of a child. Therefore, in our approach to working with children, we have adopted a strategy focusing on the overall growth of the child while they act as active stakeholders.

Staying true to the objectives of our organization with firm commitment and sincerity.

## How and where is the approach implemented?

Tabitha Home

Tabitha Home is a Child Care Institution with 50 capacities and is generally known as a Children's Home. It's the only children's home/CCI exclusively for girl children infected and affected by HIV/AIDs in the whole state of Manipur licensed by the Ministry of Social Justice/Welfare, Govt of India.



# Tabitha Home

Tabitha Home is a program under the aegis of NSCP, started during the early summers on 23rd August 2008, it is being celebrated 18th year of service in the field of children and families. It was an initiative that came into existence as a response to the cruciality of the situation. This childcare institution can also be called a by-product of one of our earlier programs- the Annual Health Camp which was organized every year up until the COVID-19 pandemic.



# Tabitha Home

Services provided to the children are:

- 1). Quality Education
- 2). Private tutor and coaching services
- 3). World-class medical services
- 4). Dietician-approved diets and supplements
- 5). Vocational and life skill fostering courses
- 6). 24/7 on-ground medical practitioner availability
- 7). Access to Mental health practitioner/therapist/counselor
- 8). Recreational activities
- 9) An avenue for spiritual inspiration by various methods of different faith groups/religions and practices



# Lead- Referral service

Referral service another program under NSCP started as a follow-up to the spearheading parent program- the annual health camp.

After the completion of each annual health camp, attendees would periodically visit the hospital and their concern doctors for follow-ups.

## Why Lead?

Often in times, when people from different corner of the state comes to the Capital-Imphal for medical emergencies and health reason as there is utter absence of proper medical institution in any hill district of the state till date. Through lived experience, as the origin of NSCP being from hill district, people are faced with enormous challenges and often fall victim to the unforeseen medical institutional business policy. The sheer lack of knowledge of the working of the medical field leaves people in a limbo with no benefits and the cycle which also even cost the patient's money, time and unfortunately, even lives.



# Lead- Referral service

Referral services were permanently adopted as a working module and perennially functioning program under NSCP and thus made effective in practical purposes

## Services received through referral services:

- 1 **Free food and lodging at NSCP headquarters**

---
- 2 **Intra-city travel and referral services at various doctors' hospitals free of cost**

---
- 3 **Subsidised discounts at top leading diagnostic centers.**

---
- 4 **Time and cost-efficient-concise consultation and diagnostic process at top leading doctors and specialists.**

- 5 **Medicine at a subsidized rate through partnering pharmacies.**

Referral services have offered its services to hundreds people from 2023 to 2024. These people have received all the above-mentioned services with additional services such as application for health card, bank account,

# Senior Citizen Welfare Program

The senior citizen home, Ukhrul which was started in the height of the pandemic had its foothold set on the need for care and services to the senior population especially in the time of the Covid-19 pandemic. It was a immediate action project which focused on the immediate needs for survival through provision of tangible products facilitated by outreach programs.

This outreach mission reached a total of 6 villages from 4 different hill districts but the most important take away from the outreach was the urgent need for geriatric care in rural hills areas. And thus the Senior citizen home, Ukhrul came into being in the July 2023 at Rarsomtang, near Seventh Finance, Ukhrul District.

The Senior Citizen Home, a totally self funded initiative of NSCP started with 8 seniors and now has 22 total senior receiving Geriatric care and services.



# Income generation program

Networking Services has been self-sufficient and self-supporting for the longest period since its inception. The organization has taken up various means to reach out to its target population while sustaining itself.

It has strategically implanted itself in the realm of trade and commerce in the state, with quality services that has made it possible to outlast and out-perform the sea of competition within the state and the region without any corporate or major funding support.

The Outlet of NSCP does not stand behind the altruistic motto or name of the organization for a pity sale and purchase rather provides quality products and services which has helped fund the various activities and initiatives of the organization.

Just as the organization has evolved, the Outlet initiative has also taken various forms testing various methods and strategies, and public and consumer experiments which have resulted in a more evolved and upgraded program under the organization.

# Tabitha flower and events

The flower and events management program is under the umbrella name “Tabitha Flower and Events” and has been a driving force for NSCP. Although under the same umbrella term, Tabitha Flower and Events are classified into two underlying sub-programs: Flowers and Events Management.




Tabitha Flowers and Events has been a fund-raising dynamo that has backed the ever-determined objectives, aims, and goals of the organization and its various programs and initiatives.





# Piggery Farming


NSCP has its own Piggery Farming, where 50-55 piglets and full-grown pigs are reared throughout the year. Sometimes we sought help from the State Veterinary and Animal Husbandry Department when the need arose. It is also assured that rearing pigs in a hygienic and eco-friendly environment will not contaminate the surroundings bringing contagious smells and germs. The prospect of the said project is more visible for a reason the food stuffs of the piglets was collected from 3 battalions of security forces- they are 69 Bn CRPF, 4th Assam Rifles, and 29th Bn of CRPF at free of cost with a sufficient amount and good quality.

## Referral services

It is such a vital important for the people living with HIV/AIDS and other contagious diseases to stayed connected with service providers for their ultimate survival means as well as prevention & control for the wider benefits of the community at large.

## Old Age project, Ukhrul

Old age care is one of the most challenging tasks in our modern days, due to the fast-paced life and heavy engagement of daily routines on the shoulders of potential caregivers. Hence, bigger accommodations and frequent healthcare activities need to be accompanied in the policy and program

## Annual Health camp/ Mobile health clinic

The annual health Camp needs to expand “The Mobile Clinic” with referer services. This project may have a special focus on rural healthcare services. In a state like Manipur, where tribal areas as a whole and people living in the border villages are completely left without Medical facilities. Therefore, these three components in the one-go project package are so important and necessary for the tribal areas on emergency services where there is no pharmacy, PHC, proper road, and communication, including internet connectivities, no electricity, water supply, and educational institutions
