

How is it different from any other Child Care Institution or Children's Home in Manipur


Tabitha is the only CCI for HIV/AIDS infected and affected girls in the entirety of Manipur


All expenses of the child are covered by the Children's Home

All necessary expenses for practical living for all children under the care of Tabitha's home are met by the institution. This is done to avoid the direct interference of any family members friends or relatives. Thus maintaining uniformity and avoiding disparity among children. All expenses irrespective of amount are thus met by Tabitha Home



Health- physical and mental is our utmost priority

Being the only Children's Home for HIV/AIDs infected girls in the entirety of Manipur, Tabitha Home set health as its utmost priority. From timely medication in the form of ART (Antiretroviral therapy), and all the necessary supplements, regular health check-ups and blood works that comes with it.

Apart from their health and education, Tabitha home realises the need of the children to be skillful and equipped in order to successfully rehabilitate into the society as well as excel in their daily life.

Old age Initiative- Services for senior Citizens are more demand than ever before

What year was the Old Age/Senior citizen program started in

The Senior citizen initiative started in 2022 at Ukhrul district and has been a slow-developing independent project ever since under NSCP



What is the story behind the story of initiation of the program?

This initiative was started as an outreach program by NSCP during 2020 in the height of the Covid Pandemic in order to reach out to people who were heavily affected by the collapse of the socio-economic condition of the world which has also affected people living in extreme poverty. Those inhabiting the hill districts regions of Manipur are one which comes under such heavily affected community. And even in such affected community, children and senior citizens bore and extra brunt as they are more vulnerable to the disease while being unable to fend for themselves and being solely dependant only others at the same time.



The impact of the Old age initiative in number



Old age home, Ukhrul

The old age initiative has taken its first step towards its goal by starting an old age home in Rarsomtang, Ukhrul district. This is fully an independent project of the organization and is not funded by any agencies or institutions. We have started the home for senior citizen with 7 inmates for the pilot period.



Area of outreach

The ongoing outreach program of NSCP is not centered in a single area. However, it has spanned out to districts both hill and valley reaching 176 senior citizens with goods such as warm winter clothes and blankets, SOS medicines, dietary and medicinal supplements



Benefits of old age govt scheme

As the saying goes, the government is the citizens's most reliable partner. Although this statement is debated, one thing is certain and that is the schemes that are available for the benefit of the senior citizens. NSCP has sought after such benefits for our target population for the long-term sustenance of the beneficiaries.

Who are the main beneficiaries of this services



What led to referral services in the field of health and medicine under NSCP

A health checkup is a follow-up action of the annual Health camp; It's a subsequent course of treatment plan made up of several cycles that might be one week of treatment followed by three weeks of rest.

Our Impact in Numbers




All services availed at NSCP are free of cost..

Services provided by NSCP comes at zero cause. This benefit covers lodging and stay, free food, travel within the city from hospitals to diagnostic centre and doctor appointments accompanied by knowledgeable guide



Discounts and subsidise rates at reputed medical institutions through NSCP

Reputed medical institutions, pharmacies and diagnostic centres who are kind enough to understand the working offers discount and subsidise rates to anyone availing service through NSCP



Benefits and accessibility of government schemes

Serious and eligible patients are also provided with more benefits from the government. This might be schemes they are not aware or not equipped to apply for. NSCP makes it a hassle free experience for all qualifying benefecaries to obtain maximum cost friendly treatment. This extra benefit is a life saver for many individuals hailing from far-flung areas.

A pictorial compilation of our services



A remnant of the COVID-19 pandemic which is positively impacting the functioning of the medical field is the introduction of online consultation. through our referral services in connection with understanding doctors and specialists, consultation, and prescription for first aid, SOS medicine, and sometimes cure for disease depending on the severity of the cases has been easily availed to people in dire need. Door-to-door blood sample collection, and test results delivery through emails and phone numbers are actions that defer from the traditional method of operation in this particular field. however, This new method has been openly and widely accepted by service providers and beneficiaries given that treatment has been made much easier.

Income generative program- We don't work for money but we earn money for the work we are committed.

NSCP has taken up multiple self-sustaining project to support itself in order to fulfill its very own mission, vision and objective since inception

All proceeds of this program goes to people in need irrespective of background, race, caste, or religion through the programs and initiatives under NSCP




Organic taste of Manipur through organic sources available in the heart of Imphal city


Referral services


2023-2024 Highlights
